ORDINANCE NO. 295-Z

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 23
of the City Code - Zoning Ordinance

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

Section 1. That Chapter 23, Section 23-8 of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by changing from O-6 to B-1 on the Official Zoning Map, City of Charlotte, N. C. the following described property:

BEGINNING at a point on the southerly right-of-way line of West Boulevard, said point being the northwesterly corner of the Coit Ashley Brigman property recorded in Deed Book 1667 at page 475 in the Mecklenburg County Registry of Deeds; 1) thence S.38-00-01W. 370.98 feet; 2) thence N.1-52-57E. 195.76 feet to a point on the southerly right-of-way of West Boulevard; 3) thence running in an easterly direction with the right-of-way of said road for the following two calls: a) N.77-24E. 98.44 feet, b) N.81-09-30E. 77.35 feet to the point or place of BEGINNING.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 686-X, THE 1979-80 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TO PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF HOUSING UNITS IN THE FIRST WARD URBAN RENEWAL AREA.

Section 1. That the sum of \$25,000 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources:


Rental fees from Apartment Units in First Ward Urban Renewal Area	\$ 1,000

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FARES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OF TAXICABS.

- "(a) For the first one-eighth (1/8) mile.....\$1.00
- (b) For each succeeding one-eighth (1/8) mile or fraction thereof..... .10."
