ORDINANCE NO. 912-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 394-X, THE 1980-81 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE 1978 WATER BOND FUND AND ESTIMATING STATE GRANT REVENUES TO PROVIDE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE SHARON ROAD WATER STORAGE FACILITY PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,530,000 is hereby transferred to the Sharon Road Water Storage Facility account (635.14) in accordance with the following schedule:

These funds will be used to construct a five million gallon water storage facility on Sharon Road.

Section 2. That the Finance Director or his designee is hereby authorized to advance \$418,326 from the 1978 Water Bond Fund to the Sharon Road Water Storage Facility account (635.14) pending receipt of the State grant. On receipt of the State grant the amount advanced will revert to the original source of funding.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 394-X, THE 1980-81 BUDGET ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCES OF FOUR SEWER BOND FUNDS TO PROVIDE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR COFFEY CREEK OUTFALL PROJECT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$190,000 is hereby transferred to the Coffey Creek Outfall Account (631.19) in accordance with the following schedule:

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ORDINANCE NO. 916

AMENDING CHAPTER 22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 22, ENTITLED "TREES", OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. Chapter 22, section 15, subsection (a) of the city code shall be deleted in its entirety and a new section substituted in lieu thereof to read as follows:

"(a) The city may apply to the appropriate court for an injunction and order of abatement for a violation of this chapter or for a violation of any rule or order adopted or issued pursuant to this chapter or any term, condition, or provision of any approved permit, requiring compliance with this chapter, and such action shall be instituted as a civil action in the name of the city of Charlotte for injunctive relief to restrain or correct the violation."

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
