

ORDINANCE NO. 1033

AMENDING CHAPTER 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13, ARTICLE 1, TO INCREASE THE PUNISHMENT FOR PROSTITUTION IN THE FIRST DEGREE AS AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER 969, SESSION LAWS OF 1981.

WHEREAS, the 1981 General Assembly enacted a bill authorizing cities with a population of 300,000 or more to increase the punishment for prostitution in the first degree upon the adoption of an ordinance which ordinance makes a finding that prostitution is a serious problem within the city; and

WHEREAS, Charlotte has a population in excess of 300,000 and has experienced the community-wide problems associated with open prostitution in certain areas of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the city of Charlotte, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. Chapter 13 of the Charlotte City Code is hereby amended by the addition of a new Section 13-18 to read as follows:

"As authorized by the provisions of Chapter 969, Session Laws of 1981, the City Council hereby finds that prostitution is a serious problem within the city of Charlotte. Accordingly, any person who shall be deemed guilty of prostitution in the first degree, as set forth in G.S. 14-207, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be imprisoned for not less than sixty (60) days nor more than two (2) years, and may be fined in the discretion of the court."

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 1034

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13, ARTICLE II, ENTITLED "OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS" OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina:

Section 1. Chapter 13, Article II of the Code of the City of Charlotte is hereby amended by adding a new section as follows:

"Sec. 13-50.

All property owners within the City limits shall provide and maintain in good repair upon their properties adequate drainage facilities to prevent the unobstructed and uninterrupted flow of natural waters thereon, prevent the standing of water thereon, and prevent flooding of neighboring properties.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 1035-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 980-X, THE 1981-82 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE AIRPORT OPERATING FUND TO PROVIDE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR NOISE LITIGATION.
