

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE  
PERTAINING TO THE FEBRUARY 1981 REOPENED OPERATING LICENSE  
PROCEEDING FOR McGUIRE NUCLEAR STATION BEFORE THE ATOMIC  
SAFETY AND LICENSING BOARD.

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WHEREAS, on 11 June 1979, the city council of the City of Charlotte adopted a resolution directed to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission requesting, among other things, that Charlotte-Mecklenburg be considered an area which should be avoided for the shipment of spent nuclear fuel or, in the alternative, that the Barnwell, South Carolina, nuclear facility be used to accommodate spent fuel from the Oconee, South Carolina, nuclear facility; and

WHEREAS, on 23 June 1980, the city council of the City of Charlotte adopted a resolution directed to the United States Department of Transportation requesting, among other things, that final regulations for the transportation of spent nuclear waste include more local participation in the selection of the routes, that transportation occur during reasonable times, and that there should be a limit placed on the number of shipments through an area; and

WHEREAS, on 26 January 1981, an order was received from the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board authorizing the City of Charlotte to participate as an interested governmental body pursuant to the provisions of 10 C.F.R. § 2.715(c) in the reopened operating licensing proceeding for McGuire nuclear station.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the city council of the City of Charlotte, in regular session duly assembled, declares:

1. That Tom Finnie or his designee shall be the official representative of the City of Charlotte in attendance at the proceeding and he shall maintain a summary of the issues raised and discussed at the proceedings.

2. That, upon receiving any recommendations from city personnel involved with the proceeding, the city council of Charlotte shall be prepared, if it deems it necessary, to have its position on a particular recommendation stated during the hearing or, at the conclusion of the hearing, through any proposed findings and conclusions or through any appeal to the commission from its initial decision or in any other way permitted by the procedures applicable to the proceeding or permitted by the administrative judge, acting as chairman for the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board that will be conducting the hearing.

3. That, if the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in its investigation finds that additional safety measures would enhance the safety of Charlotte residents, the City require implementation of such measures and further, if the safety of Charlotte residents would be affected by a Class 9 accident, that appropriate plans, policies, and procedures for dealing with the effects of an accident be developed in cooperation with City of Charlotte officials.

4. That, at the conclusion of the proceedings, a report on the proceedings will be presented to the City Council and the City Council shall make any recommendations or comments in respect to the report that the City Council deems appropriate and such comments and recommendations shall be conveyed to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO DAVID A. BURKHALTER  
FOR FIFTEEN ADDITIONAL DAYS OF VACATION LEAVE

WHEREAS, David A. Burkhalter has been employed by the City as City Manager since May 10, 1971 and during that time has rendered exemplary and meritorious service to the City; and

WHEREAS, David A. Burkhalter is retiring from City service, having submitted his resignation with the desire and expectation that said resignation would become effective on December 31, 1980; and

WHEREAS, David A. Burkhalter beneficently agreed to remain in the City's service past his expected retirement date, an occurrence brought about by circumstances beyond his control; and

WHEREAS, by remaining in the City's service past his expected retirement date, David A. Burkhalter lost, pursuant to Rule IV, Section 1(2) of the City's Personnel Rules and Regulations, 5 days of vacation for which he would otherwise have been paid upon his retirement; and

WHEREAS, by remaining in the City's service past his expected retirement date, David A. Burkhalter has also been required to make substantial payments under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act that he would otherwise not have been required to make. The contributions have been in an amount equivalent to approximately 10 days pay; and

WHEREAS, the City believes, considering the circumstances that caused David A. Burkhalter to remain in the City's employ past his expected retirement date, that it would be inequitable for him to suffer the losses caused thereby, as enumerated above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, in regular session assembled this 23rd day of February, 1981, that David A. Burkhalter be credited with fifteen (15) days of vacation leave, in addition to regular vacation leave he has accumulated pursuant to the Personnel Rules and Regulations, that he receive payment for this additional vacation leave upon his retirement and that this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting.

RESOLUTION OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL ENDORSING THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT OF THE SOUTHERN SECTION OF THE OUTER BELT.

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WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation proposes to construct a multi-lane freeway between I-77 and US 74 south of Charlotte in Mecklenburg County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Final Environmental Impact Statement prepared by Wilbur-Smith and Associates recommended Alternate 3 (the southern alignment); and

WHEREAS, the Final Environmental Impact Statement indicates that vehicle volumes on NC 51 between South Boulevard and NC 16 will exceed those on the Outer Belt; and

WHEREAS, NC 51 between South Boulevard and NC 16 presently carries traffic volumes in excess of 6,000 V.P.D.; and

WHEREAS, while volumes on NC 51 will grow substantially prior to the construction of the Outer Belt; and

WHEREAS, the Charlotte Mecklenburg Technical Coordinating Committee has reviewed the Final EIS and concurs with the need for the Outer Belt.

WHEREAS, the Charlotte City Council has concern that the Urban Impact has not been fully addressed in the EIS,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Charlotte City Council in regular session duly assembled concurs with the Final EIS for the Southern Segment of the Outer Belt and recommends the following changes:


- 1) That the North Carolina Department of Transportation establish the location of the Outer Belt and proceed with protection of the right of way as soon as possible.
- 2) That interchanges be provided only at the intersections of the project with I-77, US 521 (South Boulevard), NC 16 (Providence Road) and US 74, thus providing direct access to major State and Federal routes radiating from Charlotte.
- 3) That removal of the proposed interchanges at NC 51, Elm Lane and Monroe Road will tend to reduce urban impact and contribute to the quality of life for local residents and businesses.
- 4) That the North Carolina Department of Transportation consider the construction of a lower grade facility (two-lane freeway or multi-lane expressway) consistent with the projected traffic volumes contained in the Final EIS.

- 5) That the design of the proposed Outer Belt provide for interface with radial transit facilities including park and ride lots.
- 6) That, if the North Carolina Department of Transportation believes the interchanges at NC 51, Elm Lane and Monroe Road will be necessary at a later date, right of way should be acquired simultaneously with the remainder of the project and temporarily be utilized for park and ride lots. Construction of the interchanges would not occur until the need is substantiated by traffic conditions.
- 7) That the North Carolina Department of Transportation proceed immediately with plans to upgrade NC 51 to a multi-lane facility consistent with the projected traffic volumes contained in the Final EIS.
- 8) The the Charlotte City Council will address the right of way acquisition and construction priority in the 1981 Annual Review of the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Area.

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE  
EMPLOYEE GROUP INSURANCE PLAN

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Employee Group Insurance Plan be hereby amended as follows:

A. Add the following cost containment features:

1. Second Surgical Opinions. Charges for second surgical opinions for elective surgical procedures and necessary diagnostic tests covered by the policy will be reimbursed at the reasonable and customary fee for such consultations and services without applying the deductible or coinsurance factor. Elective surgery implies non-emergency procedures where a reasonable delay would not affect the results; no benefits will be provided for surgical procedures excluded by the policy.

If the first two opinions conflict, a third opinion will be covered, but it will be subject to the deductible and coinsurance factors.

2. Out-Patient Surgery. For covered surgical procedures performed in a doctor's office, ambulatory surgical facility or in a hospital out-patient department, the cash deductible will be waived and reimbursement will be at the coinsurance factor.
3. Extended Care Facilities. Reimbursement will be provided for medically necessary services in a qualified extended care facility. To qualify for benefits, the insured individual must have been hospitalized for a period of at least 5 consecutive days and must be admitted to the extended care facility for the same or a related cause within 7 days of hospital discharge. Benefits shall not be payable with respect to expenses incurred after the 60th day of such extended care confinement, and the maximum payable for miscellaneous expenses is \$100.

B. Amend the Life Insurance, Accident and Sickness, and Health Insurance portions of the plan to provide:

1. Life Insurance. Life Insurance, including Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance will terminate on the date of retirement or on the employee's 70th birthday, whichever occurs first.

2. Accident and Sickness Insurance. Accident and Sickness Insurance shall terminate on the date the employee retires or on the employee's 70th birthday, whichever occurs first.
3. Health Insurance.
  - a. The Medicare Supplemental Expense Insurance provision is deleted.
  - b. The Medicare "Carve-Out" Expense Insurance provision is added, which provides the same level of medical benefits for active employees and dependents eligible for Medicare that active employees not eligible for Medicare receive, provided, however, these benefits are offset by benefits payable by Medicare. The Medicare "Carve-Out" provision also applies to retired City employees and dependents eligible for Medicare.
  - c. The City shall pay the Medicare "Carve-Out" premium and the cost for Medicare "Part B" coverage under Social Security for active employees eligible for Medicare. The City shall also pay the same percentage of the Medicare "Carve-Out" premium and Medicare "Part B" coverage for active employees' dependents eligible for Medicare, as that paid for dependents of active employees who are not eligible for Medicare.
  - d. Retired employees shall pay the Medicare "Carve-Out" Premium and the cost of Medicare "Part B" coverage.

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation, an agency of the State of North Carolina, pursuant to the provisions of G.S. 136-18(12) proposes to contract with the Federal Highway Administration to obtain Federal-Aid funds for the improvements in the protective devices at certain highway-railway crossings on the Municipal Street system for which the Municipality is responsible; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality will reimburse the Department of Transportation for any and all expense incurred in the planning, design and installation of the protective devices incurred by the Department of Transportation, not reimbursed by the Federal Highway Administration; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Mayor and the Clerk of the Municipality of Charlotte are hereby formally authorized to enter into a contract with the Department of Transportation to obtain Federal-Aid highway funds necessary to improve the protective devices at the said grade crossing, for the Department of Transportation to perform certain work, and the Mayor and Clerk of the Municipality are hereby empowered to sign and execute the required agreement between the Municipality and the Department of Transportation.


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE

RESOLUTION DECLARING AN INTENT TO CLOSE A PORTION OF  
LEROY STREET IN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE,  
MECKLENBURG COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA  
AND CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE QUESTION

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department of the City of Charlotte, by and through its Director, has requested the City to vacate and close a certain portion of Leroy Street in the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, as same is shown on a plat entitled "Proposed Closing Portion of Leroy Street", in the Grier Heights Neighborhood Strategy Area, prepared by City of Charlotte, Department of Public Works, Engineering Division, dated April 28, 1980, a copy of which is available for inspection in the Office of the City Clerk in the City Hall at Charlotte, North Carolina, said portion of said street being more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

in The Mecklenburg Times once a week for four (4) successive weeks next preceding the date fixed here for such hearing as required by the provisions of Chapter 160A, Section 299, of the General Statutes of North Carolina; and further, the Petitioner is directed to send by registered or certified mail a copy of this Resolution to all owners of property adjoining the said portion of the street or public alley as shown on the County tax records as required by said Statute. The Petitioner is hereby directed to prominently post a notice of the closing and public hearing in at least two (2) places along the said portion of the street or public alley, as required by said Statute.
