ORDINANCE NO. 1272-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1184-X, THE 1982-83 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE AIRPORT OPERATING FUND TO PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION TO PURCHASE AND RENOVATE THE EASTERN AIRLINES GROUND MAINTENANCE FACILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$144,250 is hereby transferred from the unappropriated balance of the Airport Operating Fund to Airport CIP Fund 2073; 562.03 - Purchase and Renovate the Eastern Airlines Ground Maintenance Facility.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 1273-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1184-X, THE 1982-83 BUDGET ORDINANCE ESTIMATING GENERAL FUND REVENUES AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$156,885 in additional General Fund Revenue is hereby estimated to be available as follows:
