
An Ordinance Amending the City Code



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 980-X, THE 1981-82 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE 1978 AIRPORT BOND FUND TO PROVIDE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE PASSENGER TERMINAL COMPLEX.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,307,603.85 is hereby transferred from the unappropriated balance of the 1978 Airport Bond Fund to the Passenger Terminal Complex account (562.76). These funds will be used for Taxiway "M", for the mechanical and electrical contracts for the terminal upfitting, and for the owner's cost.

Section 2. That the Finance Director or his designee is hereby authorized to advance the sum of \$1,921,693 from the unappropriated balance of the Airport Operating Fund. The sum of \$1,921,693 will replace an equivalent amount of funds previously advanced from the 1978 Airport Bond Fund pending the issuance of the 1981 Airport Revenue Bond Fund. The sum of \$1,921,693 from the Airport Operating Fund will revert to the original source of funding when permanent financing will have been arranged.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
