
BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$21,300 is hereby transferred from General Fund Contingency (530.00) to the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Planning Commission (114.00.131) to fund a citizens' awareness campaign in connection with the Citizens' Involvement Process in the Transportation Action Plan.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 1115-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 980-X, THE 1981-82 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE 1978 AIRPORT BOND FUND TO PROVIDE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE PASSENGER TERMINAL COMPLEX.


BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$975,169.27 is hereby transferred from the unappropriated balance of the 1978 Airport Bond Fund to the Passenger Terminal Complex account (562.76). These funds will be used for parking shelters, toll plaza, and terminal upfitting.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
