AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1184-X, THE 1982-83 BUDGET ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND CONTINGENCY FOR THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE MINORITY/WOMEN'S BUSINESS ENTERPRISE COORDINATING PROGRAM.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$11,750 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund Contingency (530.00) account to the Chamber of Commerce Minority/Women's Business Enterprise account. North Carolina;


Section 1. That the sum of \$16,411 is estimated to be available
