## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20. SECTION 86 OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, on May 14, 1984, the Charlotte City Council approved a policy to provide for a 25 mile per hour speed limit on non-thoroughfare residential streets; and

WHEREAS, the residents of certain streets have submitted a petition signed by at least 75 percent of the residents of the streets affected; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that the speed limit on certain streets of the City of Charlotte should be established; and

WHEREAS, G. S. 20-141 (speed restrictions) requires adoption of a speed limit ordinance to amend Chapter 20, Section 86(c) of the Charlotte City Code,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

SECTION 1: That Schedule 10 referred to in Section 20-86(c) of the Charlotte City Code be amended by repealing and deleting those city school zone speed limits identified below:

- 1. Colony Road from a point 275 feet west of Picardy Place to a point 320 feet east of Picardy Place. (Selwyn Elementary School zone in effect from 45 minutes before to 15 minutes after school begins and from 15 minutes before to 30 minutes after school ends on school days only.)
- 2. Shenandoah Avenue from a point 350 feet north of The Plaza to a point 425 feet south of The Plaza. (Our Lady of Assumption School zone in effect from 45 minutes before to 15 minutes after school begins and from 15 minutes before to 30 minutes after school ends on school days only.)
