AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1376-X, THE 1983-84 BUDGET ORDINANCE, APPROPRIATING \$15,000 FOR A CONTRACT WITH THEATRE PROJECTS CONSULTANTS TO CONDUCT A PERFORMING ARTS CENTER STUDY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1376-X, THE 1983-84 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE OF THE AIRPORT OPERATING FUND AND PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR COMPLETION OF FIXED BASE OPERATIONS DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF AIRCRAFT STORAGE FACILITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF THE DWELLING AT 517 Dawn Circle PURSUANT TO THE HOUSING CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND ARTICLE 19, PART 6, CHAPTER 160A OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA, SAID BUILDING BEING THE PROPERTY OF C. Kermit Humphrey and Wife, Linda RESIDING AT 1154 Robinhood Circle, Charlotte, N.C.

WHEREAS, the dwelling located at 517 Dawn Circle in the City of Charlotte has been found by the Director of the Community Development Department to be unfit for human habitation and the owners thereof have been ordered to demolish and remove said dwelling, all pursuant to the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and Article 19, Part 6, Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and

WHEREAS, said owners have failed to comply with said order served by registered mail on the 1/4/83 and 1/19/83 :
