RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TO HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE STATE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM REGULATIONS THAT PERTAIN TO CITY-OPERATED LANDFILLS IN MECKLENBURG COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Human Resources has the authority under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 130-166.18(a)(5c) to delegate authority and responsibility to units of local government to perform all or a portion of a Solid Waste Management Program stated in N.C. Gen. Stat. § 130-66.16 et seq., Article 13B, and the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules adopted pursuant thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners

(while sitting as the Board of Health) is preparing to request of
the North Carolina Department of Human Resources that the

Department delegate authority and responsibility for administration
and enforcement of the Solid Waste Management Program to the

Mecklenburg County Department of Environmental Health; and

WHEREAS, N.C. Gen. Stat. § 130-166.18(a)(5c) provides that no such authority over or control of the operations or properties of one local government shall be delegated to another local government for enforcing regulations of the Solid Waste Management Program unless the local government consents to such delegation; and

WHEREAS, it would be advantageous to the City of Charlotte to authorize the delegation of such authority to the Mecklenburg County Department of Environmental Health in order to have compliance authority at the local level, to ensure greater compliance with regulations, to provide greater protection to surface water and ground water through more frequent evaluations,

and to ensure uniformity of enforcement throughout Mecklenburg County.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Charlotte does hereby request that the Mecklenburg County Department of Environmental Health be given authority to enforce the statutory provisions of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 130-166.16, Article 13B, "Solid Waste Management", and the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Rules adopted pursuant to that authority over any City of Charlotte operated sanitary landfill in Mecklenburg County, subject only to the authority of the City Council of the City of Charlotte to rescind such delegation of authority by the adoption of such a resolution by the City Council.
