ADOPTING THE FIVE YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR
FISCAL YEARS 1985 to 1989

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte recognizes the importance of developing long-range capital improvement planning to maintain the growth and vitality of the Community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte continuously develops and reviews the priorities and impact of capital improvement projects for the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte has a five year Capital Improvement Program based on priorities developed in fiscal year 1984 that balances the potential physical development planning with long-range financial capacity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, in its regular session duly assembled, that it does hereby adopt the Capital Improvement Program for fiscal years 1985 to 1989.
