AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1733-X, THE 1985-86 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING CAPITAL FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER MAIN ON U.S. 521 AND N.C. 51.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$370,000 is hereby transferred from Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Program Fund Account 2071;635.49 - Beam Road - 30" Main - York Road to Wilmount Road to Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Program Fund Account 2071;636.29 - U.S. 521 and N.C. 51 Main. This transfer is necessary to cover higher than anticipated construction costs for the project.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1733-X, THE 1985-86 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING CAPITAL FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER MAIN ALONG N.C. 51 FROM PROVIDENCE ROAD TO ALEXANDER ROAD.

ORDINANCE NO. 1804

AMENDING CHAPTER 7

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7, ENTITLED "CEMETERIES," OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte that:

Section 1. Chapter 7, Section 6(b) of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting the present language in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"A fund, known as the perpetual care fund shall be established for the purpose of perpetually caring for and beautifying the City cemeteries described in Section 7-2(a) of this chapter. The City Treasurer may accept gifts and bequests to the fund upon such terms as the donor may prescribe. In addition, there shall be set aside a twenty-five (25) percent surcharge on all monuments and marker foundation and setting charges, and such revenues from the sale of lots as are not needed in any fiscal year to offset the Cemeteries operating expenditures during that fiscal year."

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 1805

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SECTION 131 OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, on May 14, 1984, the Charlotte City Council approved a policy to provide for a 25 mile per hour speed limit on non-thoroughfare residential streets; and

WHEREAS, the residents of certain streets have submitted a petition signed by at least 75 percent of the residents of the streets affected; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that the speed limit on certain streets of the City of Charlotte should be established; and

WHEREAS, G.S. 20-141 (speed restrictions) requires adoption of a speed limit ordinance to amend Chapter 14, Section 131(c), of the Charlotte City Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

SECTION 1: That Schedule X referred to in Chapter 14-131(c) of the Charlotte City Code be amended by declaring speed limits on the following City System streets as described below:

<u>STREET AND DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>
1. 35th Street between The Plaza and Davidson Street	25
2. Dilworth Road East between Romany Road and East Boulevard	25
3. Waverly Hall Drive between Sardis Road and Regency Drive	25

SECTION 2: Section 1 shall become effective upon adoption and after signs are erected giving notice of the speed limits, as required by N.C.G.S. Section 20-141.
