AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1733-X, THE 1985-86 BUDGET ORDINANCE, PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR DISMANTLEMENT OF THE MARSHALL PARK PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$140,000 is hereby estimated to be available to award a contract with Dore and Associates from the following sources:

ORDINANCE NO. 1902-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1733-X, THE 1985-86 BUDGET ORDINANCE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE MUNICIPAL DEBT SERVICE FUND AND THE WATER AND SEWER DEBT SERVICE FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1: That the following amounts are hereby available from the unappropriated fund balances of the respective debt service funds:

5101 Municipal Debt Service Fund \$1,200,000  
5501 Water/Sewer Debt Service Fund 300,000

Section 2: That the following amounts are hereby appropriated to the unencumbered balances of the respective debt service funds in accordance with the following schedule:

5101 Municipal Debt Service Fund \$1,200,000  
5501 Water/Sewer Debt Service Fund \$ 300,000
