ORDINANCE NO. 2028-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1956-X, THE 1986-87 BUDGET ORDINANCE, ESTIMATING STATE GRANT REVENUES AND PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF THE SHARON AMITY AND ALBEMARLE ROADS INTERSECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$200,000 is hereby estimated to be available from the North Carolina Department of Transportation for reconstruction of the Transportation Systems Management intersection of Sharon Amity and Albemarle Roads.

Section 2. That the sum of \$200,000 is hereby appropriated to General Capital Improvement Fund 2010; 287.02 - TSM Intersection Construction.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

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ORDINANCE NO. 2029-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1956-X, THE 1986-87 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING CAPITAL FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER MAIN ALONG PRESSLEY ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1: That the sum of \$74,000 is hereby transferred from Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Program Fund Account 2071;635.33 - Water Main Along Pleasant Grove Road to Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Program Fund Account 2071;636.32 - Pressley Road Water Main. This transfer is necessary to cover higher than anticipated construction costs for the project.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1956-X, THE 1986-87 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TRANSFERRING CAPITAL FUNDS TO FINANCE TRANSPORTATION RELATED IMPROVEMENTS ALONG THE 54" WATER MAIN ROUTE.

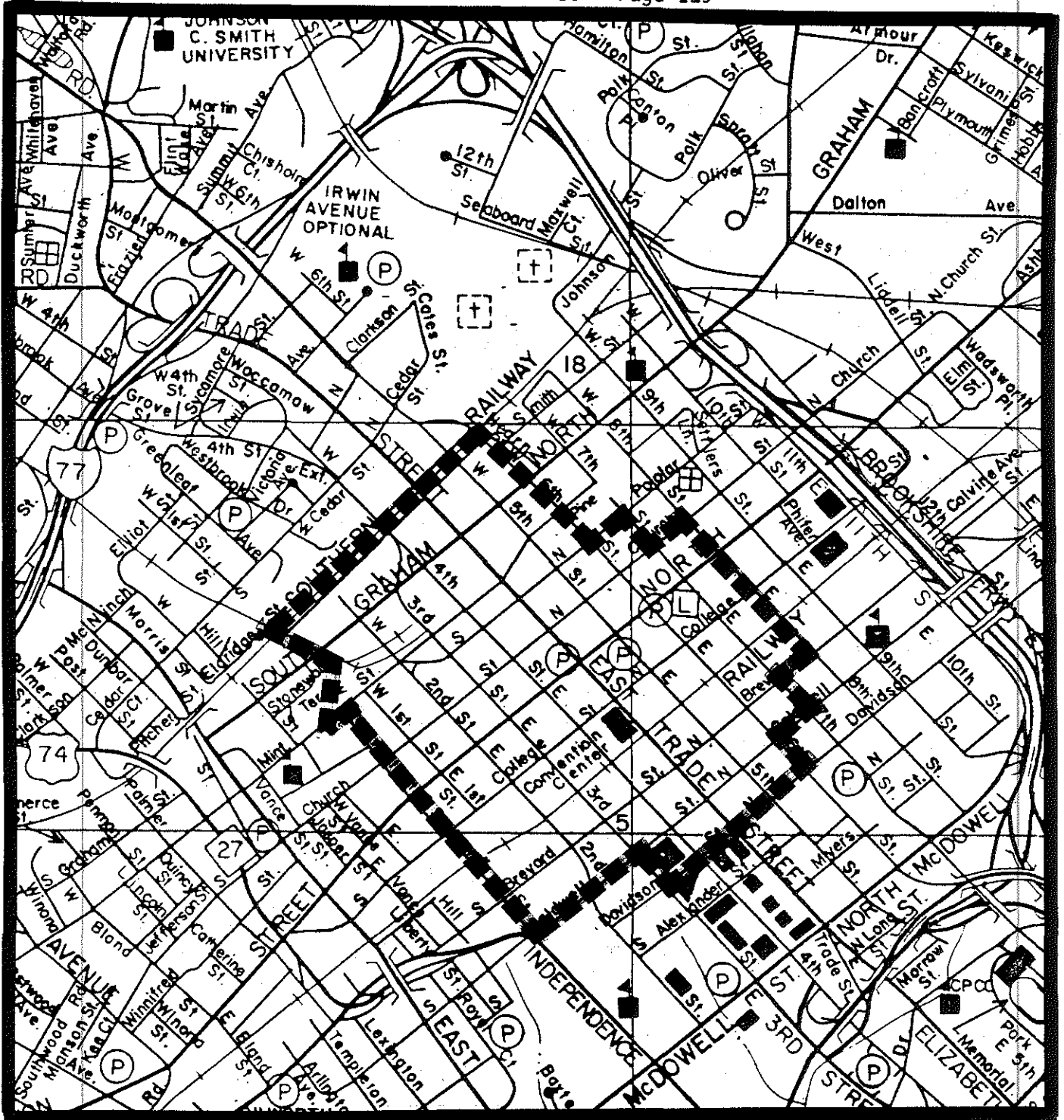

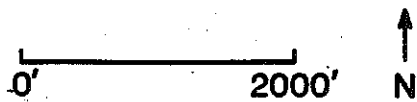

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF THE DWELLING AT
3012-12½ Virginia Ave. PURSUANT TO THE HOUSING CODE OF
THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND ARTICLE 19, PART 6, CHAPTER 160A OF THE
GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA, SAID BUILDING BEING THE PROPERTY
OF David F. Prevatte and Wife, Jackie R. RESIDING AT
P.O. Box 18752, Charlotte, N. C.

WHEREAS, the dwelling located at 3012-12½ Virginia Ave. in the
City of Charlotte has been found by the Director of the Community Develop-
ment Department to be unfit for human habitation and the owners thereof
have been ordered to demolish and remove said dwelling, all pursuant to
the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and Article 19, Part 6, Chapter
160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, and

WHEREAS, said owners have failed to comply with said order served by
registered mail on the 2/28/86 and 4/17/86 :
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

is hereby ordered to cause the demolition and removal of the dwelling located

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ORDINANCE 2034

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SECTION 131 OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, on May 14, 1984, the Charlotte City Council approved a policy to provide for a 25 mile per hour speed limit on non-thoroughfare residential streets; and

WHEREAS, the residents of certain streets have submitted a petition signed by at least 75 percent of the residents of the streets affected; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that a lowered speed limit on certain streets of the City of Charlotte is not inappropriate; and

WHEREAS, G. S. 20-141 (speed restrictions) requires adoption of a speed limit ordinance to amend Chapter 14, Section 131(c) of the Charlotte City Code,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

SECTION 1: That Schedule X referred to in Chapter 14-131(c) of the Charlotte City Code be amended by declaring speed limits on the following City System streets as described below:

<u>STREET AND DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>
1. Coronado Drive between Farmingdale Drive and Stonecrest Drive	25
2. Hunters Crossing Lane between The Plaza and cul-de-sac	25
3. Lumarka Drive between Monroe Road and end-of-street 206' north of Summerhill Drive	25
4. Walterboro Road between Elm Tree Road and end-of-street 880' south Lea Wood Lane	25

SECTION 2: Section 1 shall become effective upon adoption and after signs are erected giving notice of the speed limits, as required by N.C.G.S. Section 20-141.
