Section 1. That the sum of \$2,000,000 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources:

1981 Water Bonds (Bond Center # 42191)	1,183,452.03
Prior County Water Bonds (Bond Center # 40259)	<u>371,137.13</u>
Total	\$2,000,000.00

These additional funds are necessary for the construction of a 250 million gallon earthen reservoir.

Section 2. That the sum of \$2,000,000.00 is hereby appropriated to the Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund account 2071; 636.28 - Raw Water Reservoir.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2198-X, THE 1987-88 BUDGET ORDINANCE, ESTIMATING ADDITIONAL REVENUES FROM THE ISSUANCE OF AIRPORT REVENUE BONDS AND PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR EXPANSION PROJECTS TO THE AIRPORT TERMINAL BUILDING AND ASSOCIATED REVENUE BOND ISSUANCE REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$2,510,490 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources of revenue:

1987 Airport Revenue Bonds	\$1,730,000
Projected Investment Income	<u>780,490</u>
Total	\$2,510,490

These supplemental revenues will be used in conjunction with previous appropriations to fund capital improvements at the Airport.

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,848,258 is hereby appropriated to the 1987 Airport Revenue Bond Fund. This appropriation is necessary to comply with reserve and capitalized interest requirements associated with the issuance of revenue bonds.

Section 3. That the sum of \$662,232 is hereby appropriated to the Airport Terminal Capital Project Fund.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2333-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2198-X, THE 1987-88 BUDGET ORDINANCE, AMENDING SECTION 12 AND SECTION 13 TO REALLOCATE REVENUES TO MUNICIPAL SERVICES DISTRICTS 2 AND 3 PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND THE CHARLOTTE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That Section 12 is amended such that the sum of \$49,164 is hereby appropriated to Municipal Services District 2; and that the sum of \$240,036 is hereby appropriated to Municipal Services District 3.

Section 1. That the sum of \$272,559 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources:



THE CARRYING OF DANGEROUS WEAPONS ON A CITY BUS.


BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

Section 1. Section 15-5 (a) of the City Code shall be amended  
by the addition of a new subsection to read as follows:

"(5) Carry, possess or have within his immediate  
access any dangerous weapon as defined in  
Section 15-23(d). This subsection shall  
not apply to those persons listed in Section  
15-23(b) (1) through (6)."
