RESOLUTION TO AMEND TRYON STREET MALL CLOSING POLICY

WHEREAS, ON APRIL 22, 1985, the City Council adopted a Mall Closing Policy to facilitate the closing of portions of the Tryon Street Mall Area for the staging of events to create a stimulting environment that is condusive to pedestrian activity, and to attract people to the area, and

WHEREAS, sponsors of these events have indicated a desire to have street vendors in the area in connection with such events. However, Section 6-26 of the City Code prohibits vendors or peddlers (except Tryon Mall vendors) to sell merchandise within the congested business district which includes the Mall area, at any time except as a part of a market, festival, or activity sanctioned by city or county government, and

WHEREAS, in order to allow vendors to participate in the various events included within the Tryon Street Mall Closing Policy, and to permit sponsors to charge vendors a reasonable fee, it is necessary to amend the policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council at its regularly scheduled meeting of April 27, 1987, Section II-F of the Tryon Street Mall Closing Policy shall be amended by the addition of a new subsection (6) to read as follows:
