AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION", OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE.

Fees shall be set by user fee policies established by the City Council and shall be computed in accordance with the methodology set forth in the Arthur Young 'User Fees Study of August, 1987', a copy of which is available for inspection in the City's Budget and Evaluation Office. This schedule may be revised from time to time by the City Manager, or his designee, to reflect additional costs to the City for providing these services.

Whenever any user fee on the schedule referred to above may be found to be in conflict with a fee for the same or a similar service set out, elsewhere, the fees in the User Fee Schedule shall supersede any prior existing fee.

The complete Schedule of User Fees shall be available for inspection in the Office of the City Clerk, and a schedule of user fees for each department shall be conspicuously posted in the appropriate department."
