AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2428-X, THE 1988-89 BUDGET ORDINANCE, APPROPRIATING \$1,333,334 AS THE CITY MATCH FOR STATE GRANT FUNDS FOR THE SCHEMATIC DESIGN OF THE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,333,334 is hereby estimated to be available from the following source:

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,333,334 is hereby appropriated to the General Capital Improvement Fund 2010;299.00 - Performing Arts Center.

Section 3. That the Finance Director or his designee is hereby authorized to advance the sum of \$1,333,334 from the unappropriated fund balance of the Municipal Debt Service Fund to the Performing Arts Center Capital Account (2010;299.00) until such time as the 1987 Capital Facilities Bonds are issued.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2428-X, THE 1988-89 BUDGET ORDINANCE, PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE USAIR/PIEDMONT AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE FACILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$3,500,000 is hereby estimated to be available from the unappropriated balance of the Airport Operating Fund (7401; Pre-DBO) to cover the award of contracts for the construction of the USAIR/Piedmont Aircraft Maintenance Facility.


Section 2. That the sum of \$3,500,000 is hereby appropriated to Airline Maintenance Facility Capital Project Fund Account 2081; 524.00 Piedmont Maintenance Facility.

Section 3. That the Finance Director or his designee is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$3,500,000 from the unappropriated balance of the Airport Operating Fund to Account 2081; 524.00 Piedmont Maintenance Facility until such time that permanent financing is arranged through the issuance of Airport Revenue Bonds.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2428-X, THE 1988-89 BUDGET ORDINANCE, ESTIMATING GRANT REVENUES AND PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY PLANNING ASSOCIATED WITH FIXED NUCLEAR FACILITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$32,575 is hereby estimated to be available from Duke Power Company to facilitate planning efforts associated with emergency planning for the McGuire and Catawba nuclear power plants.


Section 2. That the sum of \$32,575 is hereby appropriated to the General Fund 0101; 402.46 - Fixed Nuclear Facility Planning.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;


Section 1. That the sum of \$573,400 is hereby estimated to be available from unappropriated Water and Sewer Operating Fund balance;

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2428-X, THE 1988-89 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TO APPROPRIATE \$257,484.57 IN REVENUES FROM THE CHARLOTTE AUDITORIUM COLISEUM CONVENTION CENTER AUTHORITY FOR AMENITIES FOR THE NEW COLISEUM.
