


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ORDINANCE NO. 2677-X _____

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ORDINANCE NO. 2681

AMENDING CHAPTER 18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18, ENTITLED "SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL" OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that:

SECTION 1. Chapter 18 of the City Code of the City of Charlotte shall be amended as follow:

- SECTION 1. Amend ·Section 18-4(d) · by deleting the subsection entirely and in lieu there-of substituting the following:
 - "(4) Land disturbing activity over which the state has exclusive regulatory jurisdiction as provided in G.S. § 113A-56(a)."
- SECTION 2. Amend 'Section 18-17(c)' by adding the following at the end of the subsection:

"If the person financially responsible is not a resident of North Carolina, a North Carolina agent must be designated in the statement for the purpose of receiving notice of compliance or non-compliance with the plan, this ordinance, or rules or orders adopted or issued pursuant to this ordinance."

SECTION 3. Amend ·Section 18-20(a)(1)· by adding the following language to the sentence ending "...civil penalty of not more than \$100" and preceding the sentence beginning "No penalty shall be assessed until...":

"Except that the penalty for failure to submit an erosion control plan shall be as provided in the subdivision (3) of this subsection."

SECTION 4. Amend 'Section 18-20(a)(2)' by inserting the words "or his agent" to the first sentence to make it read as follows:

"The City Engineer of the City of Charlotte or his agent shall determine the amount of the civil penalty to be assessed under this subsection and shall make written

ten demand for payment upon the person in violation, and shall set forth in detail a description of the violation for which the penalty has been imposed."

- SECTION 5. Amend ·Section 18-20(a) · by adding the following subsection ·(3) · and subsection ·(4) · :
 - "(3) Any person who fails to submit an erosion control plan for approval as required by this ordinance shall be subject to a single, non-continuing civil penalty of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000). Any person who is subject to a civil penalty under this subdivision may be subject to additional civil penalties for violation of any other provision of this ordinance, or rules or orders adopted or issued pursuant to this ordinance."
 - "(4) Civil penalties collected pursuant to this ordinance shall be used or disbursed as directed by G.S. § 113A-64(a)."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
