RESOLUTION CLOSING A PORTION OF ROUNTREE ROAD LOCATED BETWEEN I-77 AND A POINT 530± FEET EAST OF I-77 IN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, MECKLENBURG COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 160A-299 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the City Council has caused to be published a Resolution of Intent to Close a portion of Rountree Road which calls for a public hearing on the question; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has caused a copy of the Resolution of Intent to Close a portion of Rountree to be sent by registered or certified mail to all owners of property adjoining the said street (or portion thereof), and prominently posted a notice of the closing and public hearing in at least two places along Rountree Road, all as required by G. S. 160-299; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has agreed to construct at the proposed terminus of Rountree Road a cul-de-sac. The cul-de-sac is to be constructed in accordance with City standards and accepted for public maintenance when the petitioner and/or adjoining property owner completes development of an office building on adjacent property.

WHEREAS, the publish hearing was held on the <u>9th</u> day of <u>January</u> 19<u>89</u>, and City Council determined that the closing of a portion of Rountree Road is not contrary to the public interest, and that no individual, firm or corporation owning property in the vicinity thereof will be deprived of reasonable means of ingress and egress to his or its property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City Charlotte, North Carolina at its regularly assembled meeting of <u>January 9</u>, 19<u>89</u>, that the Council hereby orders the closing of a portion of Rountree Road in the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina as described below:

BEGINNING at a point in the northwesterly right of way margin of Rountree Road and the northeasterly right of way margin of Interstate 77 and running along Interstate 77 N. $27^{\circ}-13'$ E., 41.40 feet to a point; thence, in a southeasterly direction with the right of way margin of Rountree Road in six courses; (1) S. $47^{\circ}-46'-36''$ E., 11.45 feet; (2) S. $46^{\circ}-23'-21''$ E., 76.75 feet; (3) S. $55^{\circ}-50'-33''$ E., 70.76 feet; (4) S. $64^{\circ}-11'-08''$ E., 49.92 feet; (5) S. $64^{\circ}-52'-42''$ E., 141.67 feet' (6) S. $73^{\circ}-24'-19''$ E., 185.32 feet to a point; thence in a southerly direction with a new time S. $12^{\circ}-29'-40''$ W.,

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40.10 feet to a point; said point being located within the northwesterly right of way margin of Rountree Road; thence, with the right of way margin of Rountree Road in six courses; (1) N. 73°-24'-19" W., 191.16 feet; (2) N.
64°-52'-42" W., 144.89 feet' (3) N. 64°-11'-08" W., 53.08 feet; (4) N. 55°-50'-33" W., 76.78 feet; (5) N. 46°-23'-21" W., 79.57 feet' (6) N. 47°-46'-36" W., 0.31 feet to the point or place of beginning; containing 21,626.50 square feet or 0.497 acres of land as shown on a map prepared by R. B. Pharr and Associates, P.A., dated October 27, 1988.



RESOLUTION DIRECTING THAT STORM DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS BE MADE ON HOLLY STREET IN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, MECKLENBURG COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, Jacob Massachi has filed a Petition to make storm drainage improvements on Holly Street in the City of Charlotte, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the storm drainage improvements shall be made on private property at 2118, 2119 and 2125 Holly Street as shown on a map marked "Exhibit A" which is available for inspection in the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Charlotte, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, one-fifth of the cost of the storm drainage improvements constructed in accordance with City standards, of a character, size, type and material to be determined by the City and including grading or regrading, exclusive of the cost incurred in maintained street rights of way and the share of railroads (if any) and the State of North Carolina (if any) be assessed upon the involved lots and parcels of land as authorized by N.C.G.S. Article 10, Chapter 160A, City Charter Section 7.101 et seq, and the Storm Drainage Repair Policy, and listed on the limited petition marked "Exhibit B" which is available for inspection in the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Charlotte, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the final assessments, based on the actual total cost of constructing the improvements or the cost estimated by the City Engineer at the time of City Council approval, whichever is less, and published by the Mecklenburg County Tax Collector, may be paid without interest within 30 days of the publication, or in ten annual installments accruing 8% interest on the unpaid balance, due and payable each year on September 1; and

WHEREAS, all involved property owners subject to assessment have signed a petition requesting that storm drainage repairs be made and one-fifth of the private property cost be assessed on their lots and parcels of land, precluding the need for a public hearing.
