

A RESOLUTION OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING EFFORTS OF THE HUGO TASK FORCE AND UNITED WAY VOLUNTEERS IN RESPONSE TO HURRICANE HUGO.

WHEREAS, the HUGO Task Force, organized as a response to Hurricane HUGO with representatives from public and private agencies, has defined its mission to help make the Charlotte-Mecklenburg community a model for dealing positively and aggressively with a major natural disaster by leading the collective energies of the public and private resources in successfully addressing the following areas: enhanced and coordinating communication; community involvement; individuals with needs; recognition; and lessons learned; and

WHEREAS, the United Way's Volunteer Action Center, the Volunteer Advisory Board and the Independent Order of Foresters are actively supporting and organizing volunteers to work on private property clearing trees for the elderly, the disabled, and others with special needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte is responsible for public services which are essential to the success of the HUGO volunteer efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Charlotte City Council, in special session, duly assembled:

That the City of Charlotte supports and endorses the efforts of the HUGO Task Force in carrying out its mission; and

That the City of Charlotte supports and endorses the efforts of the United Way and the Independent Order of Foresters to organize tree removal from private property using volunteers; and

That the City of Charlotte will assist these efforts to the fullest extent possible consistent with the City's scope of providing public services and legal requirements regarding public purpose.
