Section 1. That the sum of \$100,000 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2187-X, THE 1991-92 BUDGET ORDINANCE, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM A GRANT UNDER THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION ACT (NEEA) OF 1990 FOR THE PROMOTION OF WATER CONSERVATION THROUGH CREATIVE LANDSCAPING.

ORDINANCE NO. 3306

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 "LICENSES" TO REFLECT CHANGES IN THE PRIVILEGE LICENSE TAXES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina that:

Section 1. Subsections (a), (b) and (c) of Classification (241) "Laundries, Launderettes, Launderalls and similar type businesses" shall be deleted in their entirety and the following substituted in lieu thereof:

- (a) Each steam or electric laundry, including wet or damp wash laundry and each business supplying or renting clean linen, towels or wearing apparel \$50.00
- (b) Each vehicle carrying laundry not taxed under (a). \$100.00

Sec. 2. Classification (308) Pressing Clubs or Dry Cleaning Plants shall be amended by labeling the existing subdivision "(a)", and adding a new subdivision (b) to read as follows:

- "(b) Each vehicle carrying dry cleaning not licensed above \$100.00"

Sec. 3. Classification (331) "Service Companies or Consultants shall be amended to read:

- (331) SERVICE COMPANIES, CONSULTANTS, AND SPECIAL ACTIVITY AND TRADE SCHOOLS See (101)

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1992.

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,125,000 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources:


