AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2187-X, THE 1991-92 BUDGET ORDINANCE, PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER MAIN EXTENSION ALONG BEARDS CREEK TRIBUTARY TO MATTHEWS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$19,000 is hereby transferred from Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund account 2071; 632.41 - Beards Creek Trunk Extension to Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund account 2071; 632.58 - Beards Creek Outfall Tributary to Matthews.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 3302-X

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2187-X, THE 1991-92 BUDGET ORDINANCE, TO PROVIDE CAPITAL FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FLOW EQUALIZATION FACILITY AT MCALPINE CREEK WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina;

Section 1. That the sum of \$3,450,000 is hereby available from 1990 and 1991 Sewer Bonds for the construction of a Flow Equalization Facility at McAlpine Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant.

Section 2. That the sum of \$1,350,000 is hereby transferred from Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund account 2071; 633.26 - McAlpine Creek Expansion to Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund account 633.16 - Flow Equalization at McAlpine Creek.

Section 3. That the sum of \$2,100,000 is hereby appropriated from 1991 Sewer Bonds to Water and Sewer Capital Improvement Fund account 2071; 633.16 - Flow Equalization at McAlpine Creek.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.

AMENDING CHAPTER 3

ORDINANCE 3303

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE CITY CODE ENTITLED "ANIMALS"
AS TO LICENSE FEES AND THE PRORATION OF LICENSE FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte that:

Section 1. Section 3-31(b) shall be amended by deleting the words and figures "twenty dollars (\$20.00)" and "five dollars (\$5.00)", and substituting in lieu thereof the words and figures "twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)" and "seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50)".

Sec. 2. Section 3-34(b) shall be amended by deleting the words and figures "twenty dollars (\$20.00) and "five dollars (\$5.00)", and substituting in lieu thereof the words and figures "twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)", and "seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50)". Subsection (b) shall be also be amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read as follows:

"The license fee for equines shall be ten dollars (\$10.00)".

Subsection shall be further amended by deleting the second paragraph beginning with the word "If and ending with the word "sterilized.", and substituting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:

"New owners of animals requiring a license tag shall pay the full fee if purchased within the period July through December. After January 1, the license fee may be prorated depending on the month the animal was acquired. Satisfactory proof

must be furnished to the department showing the date the animal was acquired before proration of the license will apply. A copy of the prorated schedule of fees shall be displayed conspicuously in the department as well as in the Office of the Revenue Division of the Finance Department."

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
