WHEREAS, the State has examined the Global Air Cargo System in North Carolina and found that use of an existing airport would cost the least to establish the Global Transpark; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Charlotte have continually invested in the development of a state-of-the-art hub airport, well supported by infrastructure and excellent public services; and

WHEREAS, the State can capitalize on this investment and provide a significant economic development return to the citizens of North Carolina.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, in its regular session duly assembled, that it does strongly urge the North Carolina Air Cargo Airport Authority to improve the economic competitiveness of our region and the state of North Carolina by considering Charlotte/Douglas International Airport as the site for the North Carolina Global Transpark.

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF APPLICATIONS WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRANSIT ASSISTANCE GRANTS UNDER THE INTERMODAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION EFFICIENCY ACT OF 1991.

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make grants for mass transportation projects;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs;

WHEREAS, it is required by the U. S. Department of Transportation in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U. S. Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definitive procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority businesses shall have the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts when procuring construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts, or consultant and other services:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Charlotte, North Carolina:

- That the City Manager is authorized to execute and file applications on behalf of the City of Charlotte with the U. S. Department of Transportation and North Carolina Department of Transportation, to aid in the financing of transit assistance projects.
 - 2. That the City Manager is authorized to execute and file with such applications an assurance or any other document required by the U. S. Department of Transportation or the North Carolina Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

- 3. That the Director of the Charlotte Department of Transportation is authorized to furnish such additional information as the U. S. Department of Transportation may require in connection with the application for the project;
- 4. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative minority business policies in connection with the project's procurement needs.
- 5. That the Mayor is authorized to execute grant agreements and any amendments thereto on behalf of the City of Charlotte with the U.S. Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of the transit assistance projects.
