Resolution Amending the City's Pay Plans

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective on the date of its adoption.

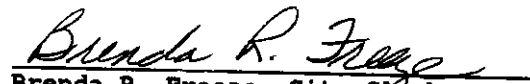
