WHEREAS, by resolution dated March 23, 1992, the Charlotte City Council and the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners approved a resolution establishing a Crime Stoppers Committee together with a reward fund; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Crime Stoppers Committee has requested that the March 23, 1992 resolution be amended to change the method of appointment of members; and

WHEREAS, City Council and the County Commissioners agree with the recommendations of the Crime Stoppers Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT JOINTLY RESOLVED by the City Council and the County Commissioners of Mecklenburg County in regular session duly assembled that:

- 1. It hereby amends the March 23, 1992 resolution by repealing paragraph 2a and b and adopting in its place the following:
- 2. It hereby establishes and continues a committee to be known as the Crime Stoppers Committee, said committee to be comprised of eight members from the community. Three members shall be appointed by the City Council, three members appointed by the County Commissioners, one member to be appointed by the Mayor, and one member to be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Commissioner. A committee member shall serve terms of two years and no member may serve more than two full consecutive two-year terms. The chairman of the committee shall be elected by a majority of the members of the committee to serve for a period of one year. A chairman may be re-elected at the pleasure of the committee.
