WHEREAS, G.S. 20-141 (speed restrictions) requires adoption of a speed limit ordinance to amend Chapter 14, Section 131(c) of the Charlotte City Code,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

Section 1: That Schedule X referred to in Chapter 14-131(c) of the Charlotte City Code be amended by declaring a speed limit on the following State System Street as described below:

 East W. T. Harris Boulevard between The Plaza and Albemarle Road
 45 MPH

Section 2: Section 1 shall become effective after signs are erected giving notice of the speed limits, as required by N.C.G.S. Section 20-141 and upon concurrence by the North Carolina Board of Transportation.

WHEREAS, on May 14, 1984, the Charlotte City Council approved a policy to provide for a 25 miles per hour speed limit on non-thoroughfare residential streets; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that a lowered speed limit on certain streets of the City of Charlotte is not inappropriate; and,

WHEREAS, G.S. 20-141 (speed restrictions) requires adoption of a speed limit ordinance to amend Chapter 14, Section 131(c) of the Charlotte City Code,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte.

SECTION 1: That Schedule X referred to in Chapter 14-131(c) of the Charlotte City Code be amended by declaring a speed limit on the following City System streets as described below:

- Hopedale Avenue between Queens Road and Hertford Road/Queens Road West 25 MPH
- Linda Lake Drive from W. T. Harris Boulevard to Robinson Church Road
 25 MPH
- Oren Thompson Road from Katherine Kiker
 Road to end of maintenance
 25 MPH
- Westchester Boulevard from Woodland Drive to Independence Boulevard
 25 MPH
- Wilbrown Circle from Nations Ford Road to Nations Ford Road
 25 MPH

SECTION 2: Section 1 shall become effective upon adoption by Charlotte City Council and after signs are erected giving notice of the speed limits, as required by N.C.G.S. Section 20-141.

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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 23 OF THE CITY CODE ENTITLED "WATER, SEWER AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL, INDUSTRIAL WASTE DISCHARGE RESTRICTIONS" TO ALLOW IMPLEMENTATION OF MORE EQUITABLE CHARGES FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina that:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 23-3 shall be amended by deleting the first sentence in its entirety, and substituting the following in its place:

"The water and/or sewer service user charge shall be a monthly charge based upon the water consumption of the property served, as measured by the water meter on the property, per one hundred (100) cubic feet of water used, except as set forth in the water and sewer rate methodology documents described in section 23-83(a)."

<u>Section 2</u>. Section 23-83 shall be amended by deleting subsection (a) in its entirety, and substituting the following in its place:

"(a) The charges for making service connections of sizes four (4) inches or smaller shall be arrived at in accordance with the water and sewer rate methodology set forth in the "Water and Sanitary Sewer Cost of Service and Rate Structure Study for the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Utility Department," dated June, 1977, as amended, by the "Water and Sewer Study Recommended Cost Determination Modifications," dated November 18, 1977 and as further amended by the "Second Amendment to the Water and Sewer Rate Methodology Documents," dated May 26, 1992 and as further amended by the "Third Amendment to the Water and Sewer Rate Methodology Documents," dated May 23, 1994, on file with the City Clerk. The above documents shall be referred to as the "water and sewer rate methodology documents." Such rates, fees and charges as are set forth in the water and sewer rate methodology documents and any modifications thereto are referred to as the "schedule of current rates, fees and charges" in this chapter. The charges

for making partial service connections 3/4-inch size shall be calculated and applied in the same manner."

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1994.
