The City Council received from the Mecklenburg County Board of Elections a certified copy of the proceedings of said Board of Elections taken on November 10, 1994, evidencing said Board's determination of the result of the canvass of the returns of the special bond referendum held in the City of Charlotte on November 8, 1994 upon the questions of approving \$69,110,000 Water Bonds, \$59,730,000 Sanitary Sewer Bonds and \$25,000,000 Storm Water Drainage Bonds of said City.

After said proceedings had been considered and reviewed by the City Council, Councilmember <u>Cannon</u> introduced the following resolution which was read by title and summarized: RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULT OF THE SPECIAL BOND REFERENDUM HELD IN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE ON NOVEMBER 8, 1994 UPON THE QUESTIONS OF APPROVING \$69,110,000 WATER BONDS, \$59,730,000 SANITARY SEWER BONDS and \$25,000,000 STORM WATER DRAINAGE BONDS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte: Section 1. The City Council of the City of Charlotte, having received from the Mecklenburg County Board of Elections a certified copy of the proceedings of said Board of Elections taken on November 10, 1994, evidencing said Board's determination of the result of the canvass of the returns of the special bond referendum held in the City of Charlotte on November 8, 1994 upon the questions of approving \$69,110,000 Water Bonds, \$59,730,000 Sanitary Sewer Bonds and \$25,000,000 Storm Water Drainage Bonds of said City, does hereby declare and certify the result of said referendum to be the result which is set forth in the following statement, which statement has been prepared by said City Council:

> STATEMENT OF THE RESULT of the SPECIAL BOND REFERENDUM held in the CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA on November 8, 1994 UPON THE QUESTIONS OF APPROVING \$69,110,000 WATER BONDS \$59,730,000 SANITARY SEWER BONDS AND \$25,000,000 STORM WATER DRAINAGE BONDS

(a) At a special bond referendum held in the City of Charlotte on November 8, 1994, 236,161 voters were registered and qualified to vote.

(b) At said referendum 36,795 votes were cast for the order adopted on August 22, 1994, authorizing not exceeding \$69,110,000

Water Bonds of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging, extending and improving the water system of said City, within and without the corporate limits of said City, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, related studies, plans and design and the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, relocation, improvement and installation of water mains and lines, the construction of a water treatment plant, the expansion and improvement of a water treatment plant, the construction or improvement of pump stations and storage tanks and the acquisition of any necessary equipment, land, interests in land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy of taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 24,925 votes were cast against said order, and that a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said referendum having voted in favor of the approval of said order, said order was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

(c) At said referendum 36,677 votes were cast for the order adopted on August 22, 1994, authorizing not exceeding \$59,730,000 Sanitary Sewer Bonds of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for enlarging, extending and improving the sanitary sewer system of said City, within and without the corporate limits of said City, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, related studies, plans and design and the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, improvement and installation of

force mains, sewer trunk mains, sewer lines, outfalls and tributaries, the relocation, repair and improvement of sewer lines, the expansion and improvement of wastewater treatment plants, the construction or improvement of lift station, interceptor and other facilities and the acquisition of any necessary equipment, land, interests in land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy of taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 24,812 votes were cast against said order, and that a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said referendum having voted in favor of the approval of said order, said order was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

(d) At said referendum 35,184 votes were cast for the order adopted on August 22, 1994, authorizing not exceeding \$25,000,000 Storm Water Drainage Bonds of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, for the purpose of providing funds, with any other available funds, for related studies, plans and design, and the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, improvement, installation and providing of storm drainage facilities on public and private property, within and without the corporate limits of said City, to correct drainage problems and prevent flooding and erosion, and the acquisition of any necessary equipment, land, interests in land and rights of way, and authorizing the levy of taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on said bonds, and 25,777 votes were cast against said order, and that a majority of the qualified voters of said City who voted thereon at said referendum having voted in favor of the

approval of said order, said order was thereby approved and is in force and effect.

Section 2. The Clerk of the City Council of the City of Charlotte shall file a copy of the foregoing statement of the result of said referendum in the office of the City Clerk and shall publish such statement once in <u>The Charlotte Observer</u>. A statement in substantially the following form shall be published with the foregoing statement: Any action or proceeding challenging the regularity or validity of this bond referendum must be begun within 30 days after [date of publication].

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
