# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SECTION 131 OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE

WHEREAS, on May 14, 1984, the Charlotte City Council approved a policy to provide for a 25 miles per hour speed limit on non-thoroughfare residential streets; and,

WHEREAS, it has been determined, upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that a lowered speed limit on certain streets of the City of Charlotte is not inappropriate; and,

WHEREAS, G.S. 20-141 (speed restrictions) requires adoption of a speed limit ordinance to amend Chapter 14, Section 131(c) of the Charlotte City Code,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte,

SECTION 1: That Schedule X referred to in Chapter 14-131(c) of the Charlotte City Code be amended by declaring a speed limit on the following City System streets as described below:

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Ordinance No. 434

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19, ARTICLE V, SECTIONS 118, 119, 120, OF THE CITY CODE:

An ordinance relating to the Parade Permit Committee and the obtaining of parade permits.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA THAT:

Section 1 - Amend Section 118 (A) by adding the word "and" after "police."

<u>Section 2</u> - Further Amend Section (a) by deleting the reference to "economic development departments" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Special Events Coordinator."

<u>Section 3</u> - Amend Section 118(b) by adding the words "except Special Events Coordinator" after the word "members."

<u>Section 4</u> - Amend Section 118(b) by adding the sentence "By virtue of position, the Special Events Coordinator shall have no term expiration." after the sentence "All members shall serve a term of three (3) years, and no member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms."

<u>Section 5</u> - Amend Section 119(a) by adding the sentence, "However neighborhood Parades requiring the basic level of service will be approved by the City Manager's appointees." after the sentence "No person shall engage or participate in, aid, form or start any parade unless a parade permit shall have been obtained from the Parade Permit Committee."

<u>Section 6</u> - Amend Section 120(a) by deleting the reference to "city clerk" and place in lieu thereof the words "parade permit chairman."

Section 7 - Amend Section 120(c) by adding subsection (12) to read as follows:

"The applicant or parade sponsor will be required to provide off-duty police officer resources to secure the parade route. If the parade sponsor cannot afford such resources, the applicant may submit an Affidavit of Indigence along with a financial statement to the Parade Permit Committee. The Committee will determine whether the parade sponsor is indigent and will determine final route, date, and time of the indigent parade. The City will provide the necessary police resources for the Martin Luther King, Veteran's Day, Carrousel, and Shrine Bowl parades."

Section 8 - This ordinance is effective upon adoption.

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# ORDINANCE NO. 435 ORDINANCE REGARDING THE TOWING OF WRECKED, DISABLED OR ILLEGALLY PARKED MOTOR VEHICLES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO CLARIFY THAT WRECKED, DISABLED OR ILLEGALLY PARKED MOTOR VEHICLES MAY BE TOWED

Section 1. The Code of the City of Charlotte is amended by adding a new Section 14-47 to read as follows:

"Sec. 14-47. Towing and impoundment of vehicles authorized.

(a) Whenever a police officer finds a motor vehicle that has been wrecked or disabled upon the public streets or ways of the city, or upon city property, or that may have been parked in violation of a city ordinance or state law, such officer may have the vehicle towed from the area.

(b) A police officer may have a vehicle removed to a police storage area in the following instances:

- (1) If the vehicle has been involved in a hit and run accident;
- (2) If the vehicle was the subject of theft;
- (3) If the vehicle was being used in the commission of a felony;
- (4) If the vehicle has been parked in a prohibited parking area in violation of a city ordinance or state law; or
- (5) If the driver was operating the vehicle without a driver's license, or while subject to an impairing substance."

<u>Section 2.</u> The Code of the City of Charlotte is amended by rewriting Section 4-3 (e) to read as follows:

"(e) Any violation of paragraphs (a) through (d) shall subject the offender to towing of the vehicle. Such towing remedy is in addition to any punishment otherwise imposable under applicable law. In addition, airport special police officers may exercise the powers set forth in Code Section 14-47."

<u>Section 3.</u> Any decision made after July 22, 1991 by a police officer, airport police officer or other official of the City of Charlotte to tow or have towed a motor vehicle and the fees or charges assessed for such towing is hereby ratified and affirmed.

<u>Section 4.</u> If any clause or other portion of this ordinance is held invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, which are severable.

Section 5. This ordinance is effective upon adoption.
