Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners and by the Charlotte City Council that the Agreement shall be amended as described in the attached "First Amendment to Agreement Between the City of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County for the Consolidation of the Charlotte and Mecklenburg Police Departments", and the Mayor of the City of Charlotte and the Chairman of the Mecklenburg County Board of Commissioners are hereby authorized to execute the said Amendment to Agreement.
