WHEREAS, under the proposed agreement the Federal Highway
Administration through the Department of Transportation shall
participate in the costs of the work to the extent of eighty (80)
percent of actual costs subject to compliance with all applicable

WHEREAS, under the proposed agreement the Department of Transportation shall reimburse the City Council for those costs that are approved and paid by the Federal Highway Administration.
