

 Any such sign, or portion thereof, which is required to be relocated due to any governmental action such as a roadway improvement, may be moved to another location on the same property.
- 2. Additions to the principal building that exceed 1,000 square feet or 5% of the building's gross square footage, whichever is less.
- 3. Structural or nonstructural alterations excluding routine maintenance and repair of the facade of the principal building that exceed 50% of the facade's area.

- 4. Any change in the existing use of the property requiring a change of use permit from the Zoning Administrator.
- Any change to the sign that is not: (1) necessitated by routine maintenance or by repairs, (2) necessitated for compliance with minimum Electrical or Building Codes, or (3) a change to the existing sign face not involving the modification of the size or shape of the sign face.

 Amend CHAPTER 1: <u>PURPOSE AND APPLICABILITY</u>, Section 1.105. <u>Exceptions to applicability</u> (3) by adding the following sentence after the second sentence:

An exception is that an adult establishment shall not be a permitted use as a vested right unless the site specific development plan explicitly provides that the adult establishment is a permitted use or the site meets the standards of Section 12.518.

The revised subsection will then read as follows:

(3) These regulations shall not be applicable or enforced without the consent of the owner with regard to uses previously approved under a parallel conditional district, conditional district or special use permit, except as provided in subsection (4) below. Development of these uses will be governed by the previously approved site plans and the accompanying regulations in effect prior to January 1, 1992. Any amendments to these approved uses which cannot be approved administratively will be subject to the requirements of these regulations. An exception is that an adult establishment shall not be a permitted use as a vested right unless the site specific development plan explicitly provides that the adult establishment is a permitted use or the site meets the standards of Section 12.518.

Amend CHAPTER 6: <u>AMENDMENTS</u>, <u>PART 2</u>: <u>SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR</u>
 <u>CONDITIONAL REZONINGS</u>, Section 6.205. <u>Effect of approval</u> (4) by adding the following sentence as the last sentence:

Notwithstanding, the foregoing, property governed by this subsection shall not include as a permitted use an adult establishment unless the approved site plan explicitly provides that an adult establishment is a permitted use or the site meets the standards of Section 12.518.

The revised subsection will then read as follows:

(4) Any conditional district approved on or after October 1, 1991, shall have vested rights pursuant to G.S. Section 160A-385.1 for the period of time established pursuant to 1.110 of these rules, except as such vested rights may be altered as allowed by G.S. Section 160A-385.1(e). Vested rights shall remain effective beyond the end of the period of time established pursuant to 1.110 of these rules for any buildings or uses for which a valid building permit had been issued during the vested rights period, so long as such building permit is valid. Notwithstanding, the foregoing, property governed by this subsection shall not include as a permitted use an adult establishment unless the approved conditional district site plan explicitly provides that an adult establishment is a permitted use or the site meets the standards of Section 12.518.
