

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Charlotte calling for a Joint Public Hearing to be held by the City Council and the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Landmarks Commission on the Question of designating the property known as the "Thies House" (listed under Tax Parcel Number 155-044-06 of October 1, 1998, and including the entire exterior of the Thies House, the entire exterior of the greenhouse, the entire exterior of the servants' house, the entire exterior of the c. 1920 garage, and the entire parcel of land listed under Tax Parcel Numbers 155-044-06 in the Mecklenburg County Tax Office, Charlotte, North Carolina as of October 1, 1998) as an Historic Landmark. The property is owned by the Frank R. Thies and Thies Realty and Mortgage Co., and is located at 544 Providence Road in the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina.

WHEREAS, the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Landmarks Commission has made an investigation and report on the historic, architectural, educational, and cultural significance of the property as described below; and

WHEREAS, the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Landmarks Commission has recommended that the City Council adopt an ordinance designating the property described below as a Historic Landmark pursuant to Chapter 160A, Article 19, as amended of the General Statutes of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Landmarks Commission has determined that the property described below meets the criteria for designation because of special significance in terms of its history, architectural, and/or cultural importance, and because it possesses integrity of design, setting, workmanship, materials, feeling and/or association as required by N.C.G.S. 160A-400.5.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, that the City Council and the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Historic Landmarks Commission will hold a joint public hearing at which interested parties will

have an opportunity to be heard on the question of the designation of the property known as the "Thies House" (listed under Tax Parcel Number 155-044-06 of October 1, 1998, and including the entire exterior of the Thies House, the entire exterior of the greenhouse, the entire exterior of the servants' house, the entire exterior of the c. 1920 garage, and the entire parcel of land listed under Tax Parcel Numbers 155-044-06 in the Mecklenburg County Tax Office, Charlotte, North Carolina as of October 1, 1998) as an Historic Landmark.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that reasonable notice of the time and place of the public hearing shall be given.
