TOPIC: AMEND COUNCIL MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 22, 1999

KEY POINTS: On November 22, 1999, City Council approved an agenda item which actually placed City zoning on a portion of the areas within the City of Charlotte's newly implemented extraterritorial jurisdiction. This was actually Rezoning Petition #99-135. Zoning changes require ordinances.

COUNCIL DECISION OR DIRECTION REQUESTED: Council is requested to amend the minutes of the November 22, 1999 Council meeting to clarify that an ordinance was approved which places City zoning on the effected areas in the extraterritorial jurisdiction.
