**AMENDING CHAPTER 14** 

# ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

Section 1. Chapter 14 of the Charlotte City Code is amended by rewriting Sec. 14-183.1(b) to read as follows:

Sec. 14-183.1. Pavement damage by large commercial vehicles to residential streets.

(b) Exceptions. This shall not apply to a vehicle that enters upon such a street for the sole an exclusive purpose of loading or unloading of materials, performing work of a temporary nature, or gaining access to other streets in the area for the same purposes, or to a vehicle that is in fact actively engaged at the time in a governmental or public purposes in carrying out its activities. In addition, this shall not apply to any thoroughfare, as designated by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Thoroughfare Plan, in a residentially-zoned district, unless such thoroughfare is posted in a manner that prohibits through trucks.
