

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO REQUEST ASSISTANCE FROM THE NORTH CAROLINA AQUATIC WEED PROGRAM FOR CONTROL OF AQUATIC WEEDS

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte, hereinafter "City", desires assistance from the North Carolina Aquatic Weed Program for the control of aquatic weeds (Hydrilla) in Mountain Island Lake, the source of fresh water for the City and other areas of Mecklenburg County; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to participate jointly in said program with other governmental and private parties with interests in controlling the spread of aquatic weeds in Mountain Island Lake; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1) The City requests that the North Carolina Aquatic Weed Control Program conduct the Mountain Island Lake aquatic weed control project in the County of Mecklenburg; and
- 2) The City assumes full obligation for payment of a share of non-federal costs, not to exceed \$20,000 for fiscal year 2000/2001, and \$10,000 per year thereafter through fiscal year 2009/2010, associated with Mountain Island Lake Hydrilla aquatic weed control project; and
- 3) The City will assist the North Carolina Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources and/or the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in quantifying its aquatic weed problems and determining the public benefits of the proposed control project in Mountain Island Lake; and
- 4) The City will cooperate with other organizations to ensure that the public will have access to the waters that are benefited by the control project; and
- 5) The City will hold the State harmless from damages caused by the City's negligence that may result from the implementation of the project; and
- 6) The City will participate with other organizations in notifying landowners whose property is adjacent to the body of water in which the control project is located and in sponsoring any public information meetings that may be needed; and
- 7) The City will participate with other organizations in notifying the public of any temporary restrictions on the use of the body of water as required by the specific method of treatment used.

Such estimated just compensation as may be determined based upon the takings required by the final construction plans.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the estimated just compensation for the property is hereby authorized to be deposited in the Office of the Clerk of Superior Court, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, together with the filing of the Complaint and Declaration of Taking.
