**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE CHARLOTTE CITY CODE
ENTITLED "OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS"**

Section 1. Charlotte City Code Sec. 15-28(e)(1) is amended to read:

"(1) Prohibit or regulate the possession, off one's own premises, of explosives, any substance which by itself or in combination with other substances could be used to make an explosive device or weapon of mass destruction, firearms, ammunition, or dangerous weapons of any kind, and prohibit or regulate the purchase, sale, transfer or other disposition thereof."

Section 2. Charlotte City Code Sec. 15-28(e)(4) is amended to read:

"(4) Prohibit or regulate the sale of gasoline, kerosene, naphtha, or any other explosive or inflammable fluids or substances, or any substance which by itself or in combination with other substances could be used to make an explosive device or weapon of mass destruction."

Section 3. Charlotte City Code Sec. 15-28(g) is amended to read:

"(g) During the existence of a proclaimed state of emergency, it shall be unlawful for any person to violate any provision of any restriction imposed by any proclamation authorized by this section. Any person who violates such a provision shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00)."

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

- Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately.





AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 1835-X, THE 2001-2002 BUDGET ORDINANCE, PROVIDING CONVENTION CENTER TAX FUND REVENUES TO THE CHARLOTTE CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU (CCVB) FOR CONVENTION CENTER MARKETING SERVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte;

- Section 1. That the total sum of \$3,354,851 from occupancy and prepared food/beverage tax revenues in the Convention Center Tax Fund (0132) is hereby eligible to be distributed for Convention Center marketing services.
- Section 2. That the sum of \$2,290,524 is hereby distributed to the CCVB for its share of Convention Center marketing services. The City will retain \$268,388 (8% of total sum) as a reserve, while \$1,130,939 will be distributed to the Auditorium-Convention Center Authority (Authority) for its share of Convention Center marketing services.
- Section 3. The distributions to CCVB and the Authority include revised estimated incentive payments separate from the total sum of revenues from occupancy and prepared food/beverage taxes. These estimated incentive payments are \$130,000 for the CCVB and \$205,000 for the Authority.
- Section 4. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately.


