

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE TO PETITION THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO TRANSFER A CERTAIN STREET SEGMENT FROM STATE MAINTENANCE TO CITY OF CHARLOTTE MAINTENANCE EFFECTIVE ON JUNE 30, 2001.

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte Department of Transportation has reviewed the maintenance requirements of the following street segment:

NCDOT Street Abandoned to the City of Charlotte

Division	County	Municipality	Road	Street Name	Termini	Length
10	Mecklenburg	Charlotte	SR 4873	Independence Boulevard	From Kings Drive to Kenilworth/Stonewall Streets	0.18 mi.

WHEREAS, the City of Charlotte Department of Transportation believes that the transfer of maintenance responsibility of the above-described street segment from the North Carolina Department of Transportation to the City of Charlotte to be in the best interest of the citizens of the area and the community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, subject to the North Carolina Department of Transportation's acceptance, the street segment should be added to maintenance by the City of Charlotte effective June 30, 2001.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHARLOTTE CITY COUNCIL THAT:

- 1. The City of Charlotte will petition the North Carolina Department of Transportation to delete from the State Road System the following street segment:**

- 2. The above-described street segment will be added to the maintenance responsibility of the City of Charlotte, and**
- 3. The above-described transfer of maintenance responsibility will become effective on June 30, 2001, subject to approval by the North Carolina Board of Transportation.**
