AN ORDINANCE ORDERING THE DEMOLITION AND REMOVAL OF THE DWELLING AT 5241 GRENELEFE VILLAGE ROAD. PURSUANT TO THE HOUSING CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE AND ARTICLE 19, PART 6, CHAPTER 160A OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF NORTH CAROLINA, SAID BUILDING BEING THE PROPERTY OF JERRY ELLISON AND WIFE FELICIA ELLISON. LAST KNOWN ADDRESS 9330 GOLDEN POND DRIVE, CHARLOTTE, NC 28269.


WHEREAS, the dwelling located at 5241 Grenelefe Village Road, in the City of Charlotte has been found by the Code Enforcement Official of the City of Charlotte to be in violation of the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and the owners there of have been ordered to demolish and remove said dwelling, all pursuant to the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and Article 19, Part 6, Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, said owner(s) have failed to comply with said order served by Certified Mail on the 14th day of August, 2001 and on the 25th day of September, 2001.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that the Code Enforcement Official of the City of Charlotte is hereby ordered to cause the demolition and removal of the dwelling located at 5241 Grenelefe Village Road, in the City of Charlotte in accordance with the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and Article 19, Part 6, Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption.



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 1835-X, THE 2001-2002 BUDGET ORDINANCE, APPROPRIATING A FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) GRANT FOR AIRPORT SECURITY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte;

- Section 1. That the sum of \$1,254,990 is hereby estimated to be available from a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration Airport Improvement Program
- Section 2. That the sum of \$1,254,990 is hereby appropriated to the Aviation Terminal Area Capital Improvement Fund (2084 -52903)
- Section 3. That the existence of the project may extend beyond the end of the fiscal year. Therefore, this ordinance will remain in effect for the duration of the program and funds are to be carried forward to subsequent fiscal years until all funds are expended.
- Section 4. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
