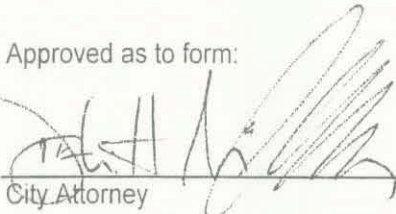

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

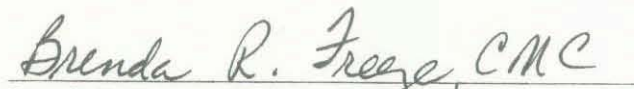

Section 1. That the sum of \$8,997,289 is hereby estimated to be available from a grant from the Federal Aviation Administration Airport Improvement Program.

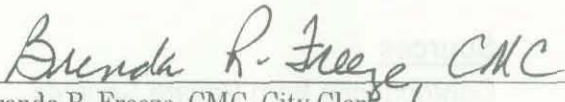

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte;

**Section 1.** That the sum of \$265,000,000 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources of revenue to establish a Tourism Capital Projects Fund:

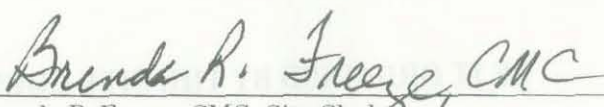
