# RESOLUTION PROVIDING CONSENT TO MULTIFAMILY HOUSING FACILITY KNOWN AS BARRINGTON OAKS APARTMENTS IN THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA AND THE FINANCING THEREOF WITH MULTIFAMILY HOUSING REVENUE BONDS IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF UP TO \$5,000,000

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Charlotte (the "City") met in Charlotte, North Carolina at 7 p.m. on the eighth day of September, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the of the County of Mecklenburg (the "Mecklenburg Authority"), [a public body and body corporate and politic organized and operating pursuant to the North Carolina Housing Authorities Law, Article 1 of Chapter 157 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, as amended (the "Act"),] has tentatively agreed to assist Barrington Oaks LLC, a North Carolina Corporation (the "Borrower") in the financing of the acquisition and rehabilitation of a multifamily residential rental project to be known as Barrington Oaks Apartments, consisting of approximately 102 units (the "Development"), located on approximately 10 acres at 7123-E Barrington Drive in the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's tentative agreement to issue its multifamily housing revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 (the "Bonds") is evidenced by the adoption of an inducement resolution with respect to the financing of the Development by the Mecklenburg Authority on April 15<sup>th</sup> and July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the proposed bonds have been allocated volume cap by the North Carolina Federal Tax Reform Allocation Committee after review by the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency;

WHEREAS, under Section 157-39.1 of the Act, before a county housing authority can exercise any one of its powers within the jurisdiction of a city, the city must request the county housing authority to do so; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it has no objection to the issuance by the Mecklenburg Authority of its revenue bonds to finance the Development; and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges that there is a need for affordable housing within the City of Charlotte;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE:

 The City Council hereby requests the County of Mecklenburg to issue its multifamily housing revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000 in order to finance the acquisition, construction and equipping by Barrington Oaks, LLC, of an affordable multifamily residential rental project to be known as Barrington Oaks Apartments located at 7123-E Barrington Drive in the City of Charlotte, North Carolina.

> 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

## RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE TO THE CHARLOTTE FIREFIGHTERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM ACT

THIS AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE made as of the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2003, by the **CITY OF CHARLOTTE** (the "Sponsor") to the Charlotte Firefighters' Retirement System (the "Plan").

# <u>RECITALS</u>:

It is deemed advisable to amend the Plan in order to receive an Internal Revenue Service determination letter for the Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is declared that the Plan shall be and hereby is amended as follows:

1. Effective July 1, 2002, the first sentence of Section 2(9) is revised to read as follows: "Compensation' means the remuneration reportable on Form W-2 earned by a Member for services performed as an employee of the Charlotte Fire Department prior to any reductions pursuant to Sections 125, 401(k), 402(e)(3), 414(h)(2), 403(b), 408(k)(6) and 457 of the Internal Revenue Code."

2. Effective July 1, 2001, the third sentence of Section 2(9) is revised to read as follows: "Effective July 1, 2001, for purposes of applying the limitations described in Section 51 of this Act, compensation paid or made available during such limitations years shall also include elective amounts that are not includible in the gross income of the Member by reason of Section 132(f)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code."
