AMENDING CHAPTER 14

ORDINANCE NO. 2667

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CITY CODE OF CHARLOTTE ENTITLED "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. The definition of "*Vehicle*" in Section 14-1 of Chapter 14 of the City Code shall be amended by rewriting the third sentence of the definition to read as follows:

"This term shall not include a device which is designed for and intended to be used as a means of transportation for a person with a mobility impairment, or who uses the device for mobility enhancement, is suitable for use both inside and outside a building, including on sidewalks, and is limited by design to 15 miles per hour when the device is being operated by a person with a mobility impairment, or who uses the device for mobility enhancement. This term shall not include an electric personal assistive mobility device as defined in G.S. 20-4.01(7~~a~~)."

Section 2. A new section, Section 14-130, shall be added to Chapter 14 of the City Code to read as follows:

"Sec. 14-130. Driving on sidewalk.

It shall be unlawful to drive or operate a vehicle upon any sidewalk or sidewalk area except at a permanent or temporary driveway. This provision shall not be applicable to non-motorized bicycles, which may be operated on sidewalks, except as provided in section 14-251."
