Section 6. That the existence of these projects may extend beyond the end of the fiscal year. Therefore, this ordinance will remain in effect for the duration of the project and funds are to be carried forward to subsequent fiscal years until all funds are expended or the project if officially closed.

Section 7. This ordinance estimates state grant participation. Upon receipt of the grant assistance, the sources and levels of funding for the project specified may be adjusted to reflect permanent financing:. Until permanent financing is realized, the Finance Director is hereby authorized to advance funding from Fund 7801 fund balance to cover estimated grant revenues specified above. Upon receipt of grant revenues, funds advanced to the projects shall revert back to the Fund 7801 fund balance. If grant funding is not realized, the advance may be designated as the permanent source of funding. The total project appropriation level will not exceed the amounts specified, unless amended by subsequent a ordinance.
