ORDINANCE NO. 2995

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE IV, OF THE CITY CODE,
ENTITLED "GROUND TRANSPORTATION AT AIRPORT"**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH
CAROLINA THAT:

Section 1. Chapter 4, Article IV, Section 4-102 is amended by adding the following
definitions, which shall be placed in alphabetical order among the existing definitions:

Off-airport parking courtesy vehicle means any vehicle provided by an off-airport
parking operator and used to transport persons between the parking operator's premises and the
airport without a direct fee being charged by the persons being transported.

Off-airport parking operator means any entity that operates a parking business, which is
not located on the Airport premises, and which markets its parking and/or other services to
passengers arriving and departing from the Airport.

Section 2. Chapter 4, Article IV, Section 4-107 is amended by deleting section (2), which
reads:


(2) *Off-airport parking. A fee per entry into the commercial lane by each off-airport
parking ground transportation vehicle;*

and replacing it with:

(2) *Off-airport parking operators. A fee equal to 10% of the operator's gross revenues.*

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2005.
