AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2996-X, THE 2005-2006 BUDGET ORDINANCE, APPROPRIATING FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION GRANT FUNDS FOR THE RUNWAY 18L SAFETY AREA IMPROVEMENTS AND DESIGN OF WALLACE NEEL ROAD, PHASE I.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte;

Section 1. That the sum of \$4,899,894 is hereby estimated to be available from Federal Aviation Administration grant funds.

Section 2. That the sum of \$4,875,000 is hereby appropriated to the Airport Capital Projects Fund 2087 - 529.61


Section 3. That the sum of \$24,894 is hereby appropriated to the Airport Capital Projects Fund 2087 - 529.40

Section 4. That the existence of the project may extend beyond the end of the fiscal year. Therefore, this ordinance will remain in effect for the duration of the program and funds are to be carried forward to subsequent fiscal years until all funds are expended.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2996-X, THE 2005-2006 BUDGET ORDINANCE, APPROPRIATING \$860,000 OF AIRPORT CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDS TO THE DEBT SERVICE FUND TO REIMBURSE THE AIRPORT FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE 1997 MASTER PLAN LAND ACQUISITION



AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2996-X, THE 2005-2006 BUDGET ORDINANCE PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE ANDOVER/MCALWAY WATER MAIN PROJECT
