Section 1. That the sum of \$175,000 is hereby estimated to be available from the following sources of funding:





WHEREAS, the dwelling located at 1326 1,2,3 Pecan Ave in the City of Charlotte has been found by the Code Enforcement Official of the City of Charlotte to be in violation of the Housing Code of the City of Charlotte and the owners thereof have been ordered to demolish and remove said dwelling; and



Section 1. That the sum of \$750,000 is available from Airport Excluded Centers Fund Balance


Section 2. That the sum of \$750,000 is hereby appropriated to the Airport Capital Projects Fund 2073 - 563.23

Section 1. That the sum of \$500,000 is available from Airport Excluded Centers Fund Balance to be replaced by bonds or some other source of permanent funding.



- Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.


