Chapter 11 of the Charlotte City Code is amended by rewriting subsection (g) of Sec. 11-77 to read as follows:

"(g) There shall be at least 70 square feet of bedroom floor space for the first occupant; at least 50 square feet for each additional occupant (Children one year of age and under shall not be counted)."
