

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA, AUTHORIZING THE FILING AND EXECUTION OF APPLICATIONS WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, AND THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR FY 2014 National Infrastructure Investments Grant Program.

A motion was made by Councilmember Howard and seconded by Councilmember Kinsey for the adoption of the following Resolution and upon being put to a vote was duly adopted:

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) is soliciting applications for competitive grants under the Federal National Infrastructure Investment Grants Program (FY2014 TIGER Discretionary Grants), authorized in the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014;

WHEREAS, the federal and state governments are authorized to make grants for transportation projects;

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance may impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of project costs;

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Applicant that minority business enterprise be utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with these projects, and that definitive procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority businesses shall have the maximum feasible opportunity to compete for contracts when procuring construction contracts, supplies and equipment contracts, or consultant and other services.

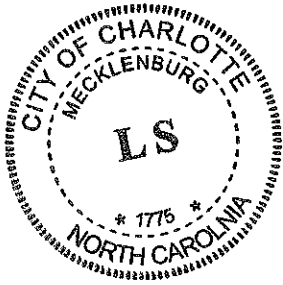
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Charlotte, North Carolina, in its regular session duly assembled, as follows:

1. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute and file applications on behalf of the City of Charlotte with the U.S. Department of Transportation and the North Carolina Department of Transportation to aid in the financing of transportation infrastructure assistance;
2. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute and file with such applications an assurance or any other document required by the U.S. Department of Transportation or the North Carolina Department of Transportation effectuating the purposes of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964;
3. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to set forth and execute affirmative minority business policies in connection with a project's procurement needs;
4. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute grant agreements and any amendments thereto on behalf of the City of Charlotte with the U.S. Department of Transportation and the North Carolina Department of Transportation for aid in the financing of transportation infrastructure assistance projects.

**RESOLUTION in SUPPORT of CENTRALINA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMEMNTS'
SUBMISSION of a PROPOSAL to U.S. COMMERCE EDA,
INVESTING IN MANUFACTURING COMMUNITIES PARTNERSHIP
FOR DESIGNATION AS AN IMCP "MANUFACTURING COMMUNITY"**

WHEREAS, the Centralina Council of Governments (CCOG) desires to submit a proposal for designation as a Manufacturing Community to the U.S. Economic Development Administration (EDA) in response to the EDA's announcement of a Federal Interagency Competition titled "Fiscal Year 2014 Investing in Manufacturing Communities Partnership"; and

WHEREAS, designation as a Manufacturing Community by the Investing in Manufacturing Communities Partnership (IMCP) will only be awarded to twelve communities nationwide and will confer on the designees exclusive benefits, including:

- Preferential consideration (or supplemental awards) for selected federal funding streams offered through IMCP Participating Agencies (IMCP Grants);
- A Point of Contact to help access federal economic developing funding and other assistance;
- Branding and promotion as a Manufacturing Community that may help attract investors and other partners;
- Possible consideration for federal financial assistance through EDA Challenge Grant Awards; and

WHEREAS, Designation as an IMCP "Manufacturing Community" will facilitate the implementation of the economic development strategies generated through the efforts of the Global Charlotte Manufacturing Community Consortium and the 2012-2017 Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy (CEDS) that identified Advanced Manufacturing as a distinctive competency of the region supporting the region's Manufacturing Super-cluster of six industry sectors, including Financial Services, Logistics & Global Commerce, Aerospace and Defense, Automotive, Biomedical, Healthcare, and Energy; and

WHEREAS, CCOG's proposal to the EDA for designation as a Manufacturing Community assesses the Manufacturing Ecosystem for the region's Manufacturing Super-cluster, identifies gaps, and presents implementation strategies for addressing those gaps and making the Region uniquely competitive in this Super-cluster; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED that the City of Charlotte strongly supports CCOG's submission of a Proposal for Designation as a Manufacturing Community to the EDA; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that should such designation as an IMCP "Manufacturing Community" be awarded, the City of Charlotte will collaborate with CCOG on any federal assistance opportunities that may be available to designated Manufacturing Communities to carry out the strategies presented in CCOG's Proposal for Designation as a Manufacturing Community.

Whereas, the City's Public Art Policy outlines guidelines that allow public-spirited citizens to donate works of art to help beautify the City;

Whereas, the Arts & Science Council has expressed interest in using a portion of its 2012 National Endowment for the Arts "Our Town Grant" to commission and install a temporary painting at the I-277/North Tryon Street underpass, which is a North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) right-of-way;

Whereas, City staff, the Arts & Science Council, and Public Art Commission have identified the I-277/North Tryon Street underpass as an appropriate location for Public Art that will help build excitement about upcoming business corridor enhancements scheduled to take place on North Tryon Street;

Whereas, the NCDOT adopted the North Carolina Public Art on the Right of Way Policy in December 2010, recognizing that transportation facilities enhanced by public art elements provide aesthetic and cultural benefits to a community that can potentially result in positive economic development and tourism both locally and throughout North Carolina; and


Whereas, the North Carolina Public Art on the Right of Way Policy provides that local government agencies may request placing Public Art on NCDOT rights of way, provided the local government conforms to the Policy's parameters and procedures, to include, but not limited to an encroachment permit, financial responsibility for construction and maintenance of the Public Art, and an adopted local resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, at its regularly scheduled session of April 14, 2014, that it supports the City's application to the NCDOT for locating Public Art at the underpass of I-277 and North Tryon Street in accordance with the North Carolina Public Art on the Right of Way Policy.

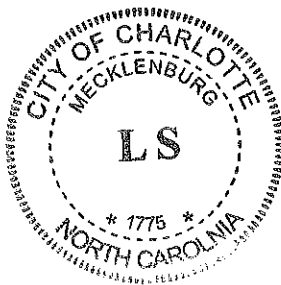
1. The City-County Tax Collector has collected property taxes from the taxpayers set out on the list attached to the Docket.

3. The amounts listed on the schedule were collected through either a clerical or assessor error.



3. The amounts listed on the schedule were collected through either a clerical or assessor error.


