RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO ABANDON AND CLOSE an alleyway off of W. 28<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County, North Carolina

Whereas, **Star Investments Group**, **LLC** has filed a petition to close an alleyway off of W. 28<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Charlotte; and

Whereas, an alleyway off of W. 28<sup>th</sup> Street is located approximately 181 feet northwest from the intersection of W. 28<sup>th</sup> Street and N. Tryon Street, running 195 feet in a northeastward direction to its terminus, and consists of 1943 square feet, as shown in the map marked "Exhibit A" and is more particularly described by metes and bounds in the document marked "Exhibit B" all of which are available for inspection in the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Charlotte, North Carolina; and






